She introduced Troy Dayak (former professional and National Team player, CYSA Hall of Fame, and currently coach of California Cougars and Director of Coaching in Livermore Youth Soccer League.) Troy recently returned from a trip to World Cup. He shared his perceptions and experiences with the District III group.

ODP – Joe Cambra reported that District III ODP tryouts had taken place in May and June. District pools have been selected. There is an average of 28 players per pool. Coaches have been instructed to have their preliminary roster of 20 players to Joe no later than August 15<sup>th</sup>. The final rosters are due September 1<sup>st</sup>. Joe reported that the leagues have been extremely helpful in providing practice fields for the ODP teams.

Recreation – Chris Hayes reported that he had prepared a draft schedule for the District III Recreational League. He is waiting for information from Dublin. Two potential play dates are essentially eliminated due to PSAT/SAT testing dates and the high school homecomings. Due to the tight schedule, it will be nearly impossible to include any teams that apply at this date from outside of District III.

Rec Plus – Chris Hayes reported that the Rec Plus league currently includes 22 teams from San Ramon and 44 teams from Mustang. Scheduling the Season Sunset will be challenging as the age groupings do not have the perfect numbers for creating tournament brackets. Chris asked that League Representatives inform their recreational teams of the tournament as it does not conflict with Crossroads Tournament this year.

TOPSoccer – Lisa Douglas asks that all leagues interested in participating in the TOPSoccer Program should contact her for the possibility of scheduling inter-league play.
