Presentation by Danny Marquez, Recreation Committee Chairman.

Focus this year on Rec soccer—including Division 3 player equal about 90% of the kids.

1) Pre F course—concentrate on promoting this. Many good things to offer for the first year coach. It is a 3 hour course (90 minute field session and 90 minute class). Leagues and clubs need to identify trainers/mentors to work with the first year parents. State would like the mentors to have a D license and take the train the trainer class. Coordinate with the recreation coordinator (Cory) for u6, 8, 10 first year coaches. Also support the mentoring program of the referees.

2) Resources, if needed, to help with any programs for sideline behavior—i.e. Positive coaching Alliance.

3) Development of Resource Guides for Clubs/Leagues. Levels for volunteer to help train and retain volunteer. (fields, equipment, fundraisers, treasurers, registrars, etc.) Help create simple, small, effective job description. Trying to work with the Referee and Coaching committees to keep all on the same page.
