### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

### REPORTS

Treasurer – No report

Registrar– Diane Scott reported that she is current in processing of registration packets. Diane informed the league reps that she will be strictly enforcing the deadlines next season. Any Division 1 packets that are not submitted by June 1 and any Division 3 packets that are not submitted by July 1 will be held for processing until September 1. Diane distributed the new disciplinary verification postcards that teams must have signed by the referee to record the games that have been served by sent of players and coaches. She will not release the pass until she receives the postcard verifying that the penalty has been served. She tried using the “honor” system last year and over 30 of 100 were not returned.

Recreation – Corey Nelson reported that she currently has 58 Division 4 teams signed up for the District Traveling House league. She has not received information from Fremont as to whether or not their U16 Boys teams will participate in the league. Two teams from North Valley YSL in District II will participate in the league. Chris Hayes will serve as the league scheduler.

Rules and Revisions – Jeff Jaye reported that he and Brian Leonard are working together to prepare some proposed rules changes. They will present their finalized proposals to the league representatives.

Al Caffodio League – Brian Leonard reported that the AC League schedules are nearly completed and should be finalized this week. The coaches’ meeting is at 7:30 PM on August 23<sup>rd</sup> at the San Ramon Community Center. An email reminding coaches of the date and time will be sent this week.
